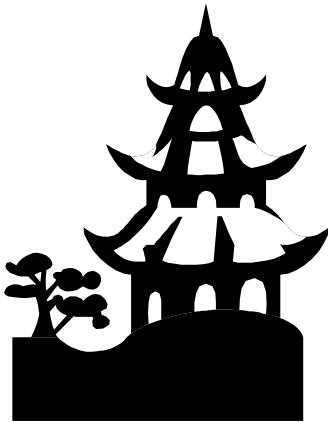

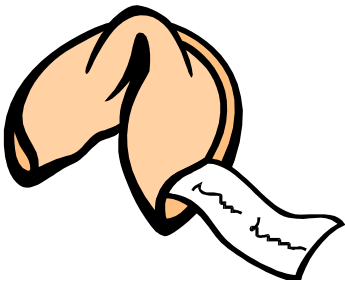

(CSWV) was established to teach the Chinese language and introduce Chinese culture to residents of the Wabash Valley. Our initial focus is teaching Mandarin Chinese to children ages 5 and above, and to provide continuing education to children of native speakers. At the same time we hope to provide adults with the basics of conversational Mandarin.

Our instructors are Asian natives currently residing in the Wabash Valley who wish to utilize their time and talents sharing their language and cultural experiences with others.

NOW ACCEPTING REGISTRATIONS FOR FALL 2011.

All classes are held on Saturdays at University Hall on the campus of Indiana State University, 401 N. 7th Street, Terre Haute.

Non-heritage classes are 1½ hours long with one 2 hour class on Chinese culture each month. Heritage and Adult classes are 2 hours long each week.

☪ Non-heritage Class for beginning language learners age 5 and above. Parent participation is encouraged to assist in student learning.

☪ Heritage Class for K-12 children of native speakers of Mandarin. Focus is on Reading and Writing of Chinese.

☪ Adult Class for beginning language learners with focus on conversational Mandarin Chinese.

- Tuition is \$90 for the fall semester or \$35 per month per student.
- Registration fee is \$25. Textbook fees will vary based on selected class.
- Payment is due the first class of each month. A late fee of \$5 per class will be assessed if monthly tuition is not paid before the beginning of the following month.

Saturday, September 10, 10:00 am in Room 209A of University Hall.

All classes will begin at designated times on Saturday, September 17.

Full dates and times will be distributed in the CSWV Handbook to be distributed at registration.
