Check out my recent schedule:

May 2011: St. Mary-of-the-Woods Student Night—St. Mary-of-the-Woods, IN
Handwriting analysis performed for the students, who were particularly interested in traits exhibited by successful people, as well as “serial killer traits”. Graphotherapy (changing your handwriting to change your traits/success probability) was also discussed and examples shown so students could begin working on improving successful traits of high self-esteem and goal-setting.

April 2011: ICUL (Illinois Credit Union League) Annual Conference—Chicago, IL
“Do You Write Like A Millionaire?”

This presentation highlighted traits found in millionaires’ handwriting, both famous and infamous. A handy checklist was provided for participants so they could check off their millionaire traits and see how they stacked up. Scientific methods for studying handwriting were highlighted. Graphotherapy, a process used for changing your handwriting to effect positive behavioral changes was discussed, and a question and answer period yielded a great informational close.

April 2011: Celebration of the Arts & Soul (A Fundraiser for the Clay County Humane Society) - Brazil, IN

Handwriting analysis for show patrons was offered, with 20% of proceeds going to the Clay County Humane Society. Traits found in “millionaire handwriting” was shown and discussed with interested patrons, as well as graphotherapy suggestions for their own handwriting practice.

April 2011: SGMP (Society of Government Meeting Professionals) hosts the CVBs (Convention & Visitors' Bureaus) - Indianapolis, IN

Analyzed handwriting for meeting planners, suppliers and guests. The topic of interest this time was improving success traits and how their handwriting could be changed to attain the millionaire mindset.

February 2011: Live radio interview on the Kim Pagano Show—Ventura, CA

This interview covered basics of handwriting analysis history, how it's used today for business and law enforcement, ways to improve your success profile with graphotherapy and things you cannot see in handwriting.

February 2011: Valentine Show radio interview on the Mix-FM Morning Show—Terre Haute, IN

This interview analyzed radio show staff, as well as some listeners who had faxed or dropped off samples. I did a compatibility review of several couples, as well as noted some revealing information about the morning show hosts and the station owner.

June 2010: SGMP (Society of Government Meeting Professionals) Board Meeting—Indianapolis, IN

"How Well Do You Know Your Fellow Board Members?"

Presented an icebreaker to facilitate getting to know new members on the board. Showed the members where sensitivity to criticism, open-mindedness, defiance and self-esteem show up in handwriting. The last exercise allowed members to pass their handwritten samples to the person next to them, for a fun and interactive way to analyze each other & learn about their personality at the same time.

May 2010: Fraud & Scam Awareness Expo—Terre Haute, IN

Analyzed handwriting for participants and presenters, emphasizing the way handwriting analysis is used by FDE's (Forensic Document Examiners) in detecting fraud and forgeries for entities such as the FBI and CIA, as well as how physical influences (drugs, alcohol) can affect handwriting.

April 2010: SGMP (Society of Government Meeting Professionals) hosts the CVBs (Convention & Visitors' Bureaus) - Indianapolis, IN

Analyzed handwriting for meeting planners, suppliers, and CVB exhibitors, emphasizing leadership qualities found in handwriting and changes in handwriting that can help improve your leadership profile. Handwriting samples from celebrities and famous people were on display via Powerpoint.

April 2010: Indiana State University "Celebrate You" Program—Terre Haute, IN

Analyzed handwriting for the many young ladies (and some of their moms) who came to this event, and showed them things about their handwriting they can change to improve their success profile. This event celebrated women and provided workshops and demonstrations.

November 2009: IRSA (Indiana Recreational Sports Association) Fall Conference Workshop Presentation—Terre Haute, IN

“Get the EDGE– Using Handwriting Analysis to Improve Working Relationships & Hiring”

It’s been said that when selecting a job candidate, you should consider two issues only: capability (*what the candidate can do*), and personality (*what the candidate is like*). Of these two, personality is by far the more important. Statistically, 87% of all people fail not because of capability, but because of personality. Wouldn’t it give you a great edge in your interpersonal relationships and hiring methods, if you could know more about someone in the first 3 minutes of meeting them than you might find out all year? January 2009: NIRSA (National Intramural & Recreational Sports Association) Region III Student Lead-ON (Analyses / 300 participants) - Champaign, IL

Analyzed student leaders and staff at social event. Students were particularly curious about dating & relationship issues shown in handwriting.
